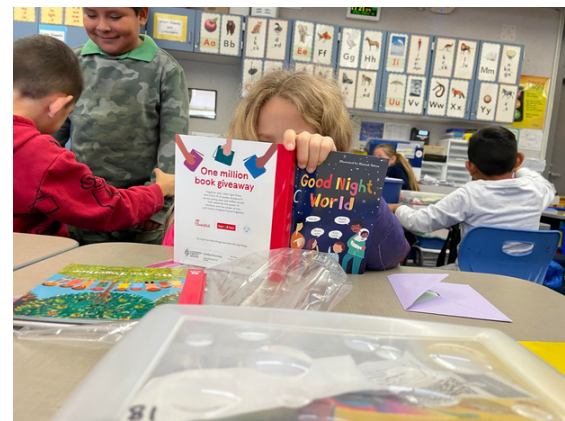
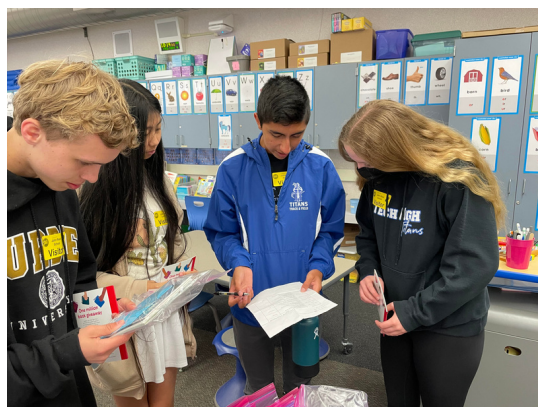
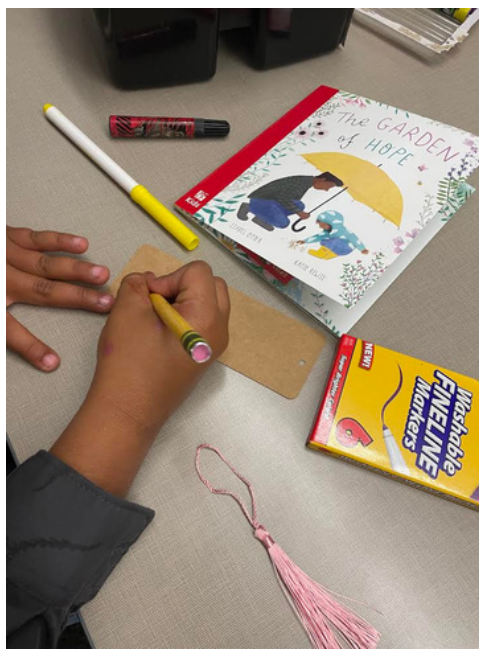


## Tech High Visits John Reed
