CVT Domestic Partner Registration to Maintain Insurance Coverage

CVT began requiring state registration for Domestic Partners on October 1, 2018. Since that time, we have allowed all existing unregistered domestic partners to remain covered without having to submit proof of registration.

Starting July 1, 2023, however, CVT will require that all domestic partners be registered with the state, with proof of registration submitted to CVT in order to remain eligible for CVT benefits. CVT members with domestic partners will receive a letter during the week of May 8 providing instructions on how to submit this required documentation. Following this letter, CVT will communicate with members four additional times before the deadline of July 1, 2023.
